Dear Mr. Hutchins:

On January 12, 1989, we met to discuss the above-captioned grievances currently pending national level arbitration.

During this discussion we agreed that there is no national interpretive issue presented.

Accordingly, we agreed to remand these cases to the regional level for further processing.

If it is determined that the disability is permanent, management's actions in removing the grievant from her bid assignment were proper. If, however, the disability is determined to be temporary, the decision of Arbitrator Mittenthal, case H8N-5B-C 22251 (copy attached) should be applied.

Please sign and return the enclosed copy of this letter as your acknowledgment of agreement to remand these case nos. H1N-3W-C 30804, 30746, 29819, and remove them from the pending national arbitration listing.
