MEMORANDUM FOR REGIONAL POSTMASTERS GENERAL

SUBJECT: 90/10 Staffing

Article 7, Section 3A of the USPS-APFU/NALC National Agreement requires that all postal installations which have 200 or more man years of employment in the regular work force be staffed with 90% full-time employees. To ensure compliance with this provision, each affected installation is to be notified to make a staffing review each accounting period.

If upon review, an affected installation is not in compliance, immediate action is to be taken to comply with the 90% full-time requirement. It should be noted, however, that pursuant to Article 12, Section 5B2 of the USPS-APFU/NALC National Agreement, the withholding of positions to accommodate excess employees is permitted. Except for those positions being withheld to accommodate reassigned employees the installation must be staffed with 90% full-time employees. This staffing requirement is a firm commitment, and failure to comply is unacceptable.
